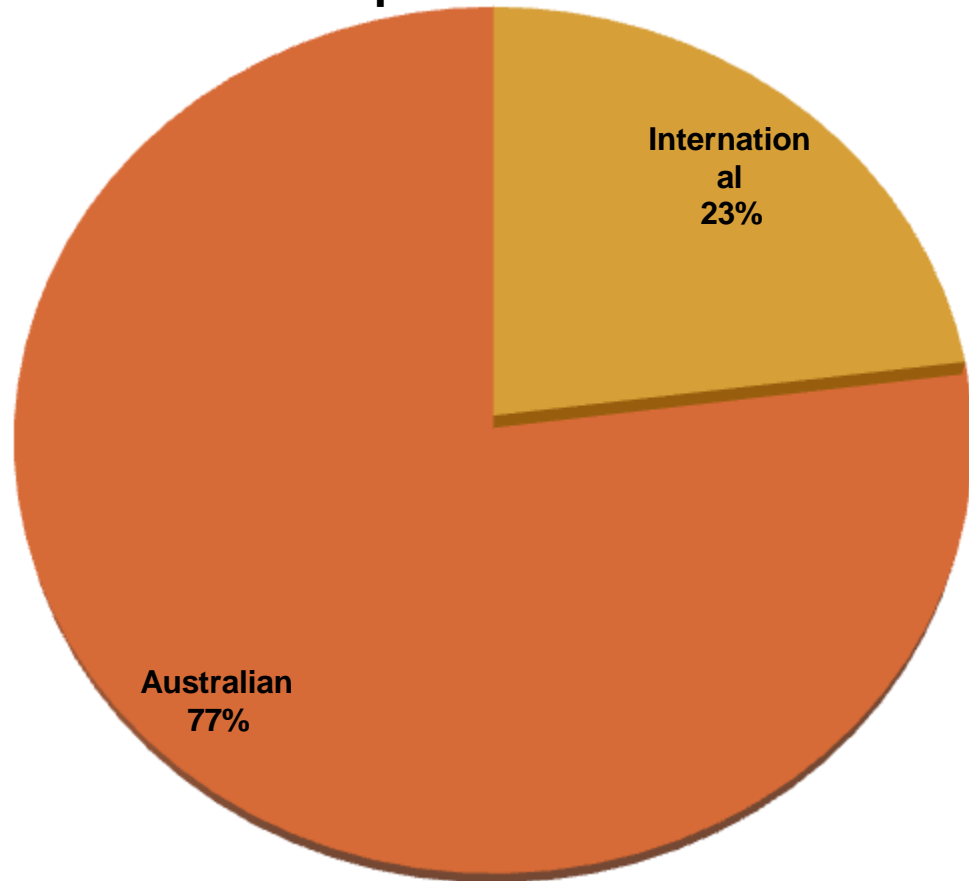

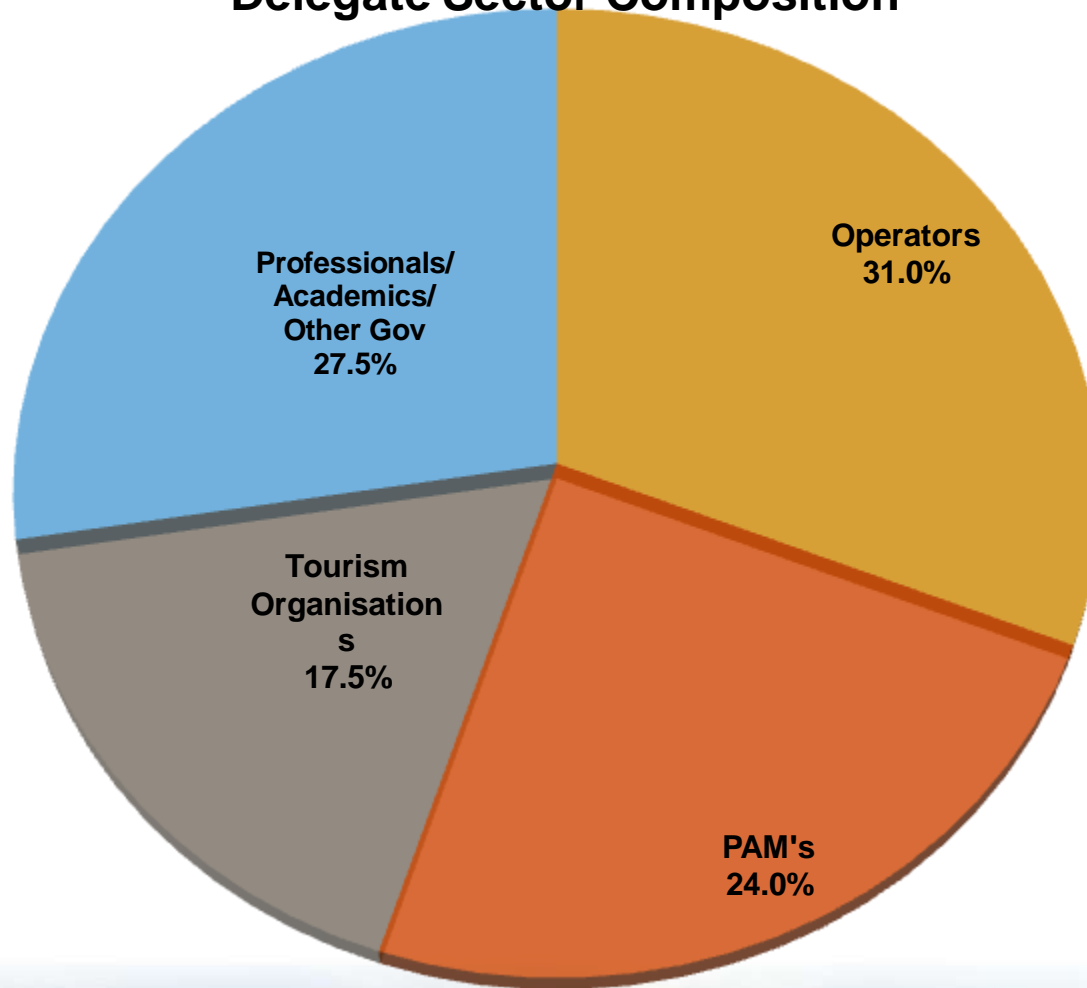


Delegate Origin Composition 20 Nations represented



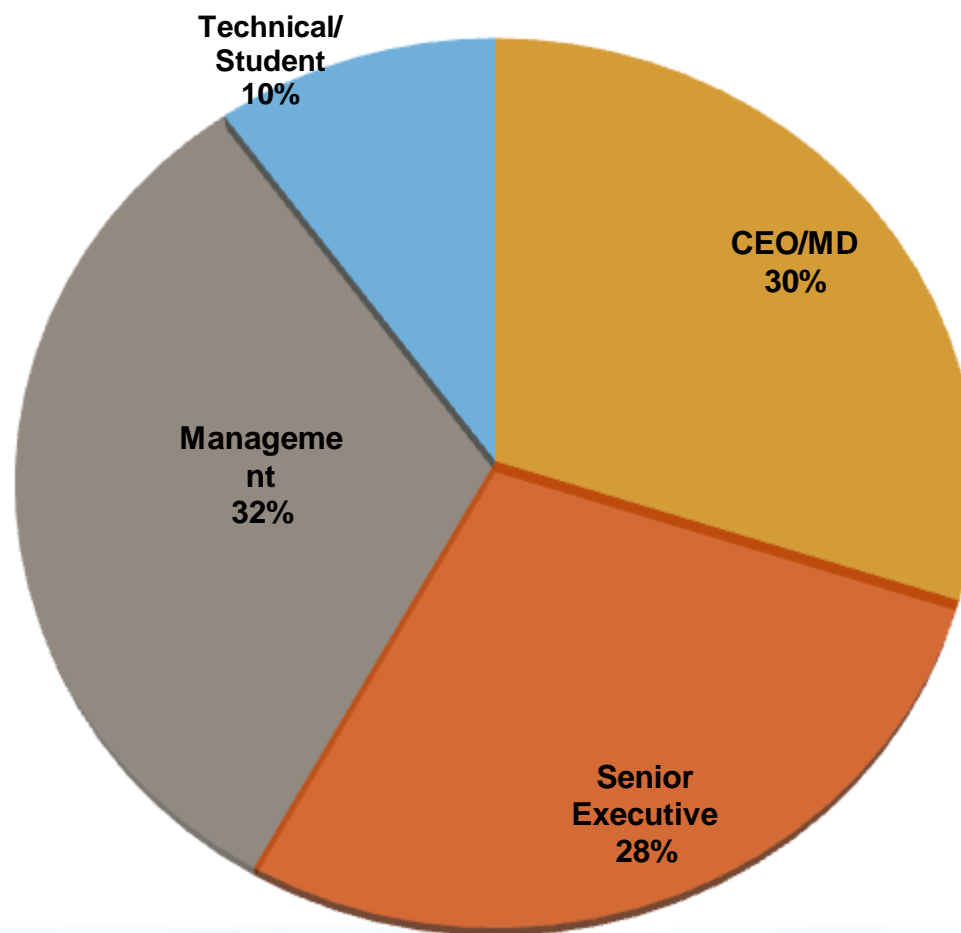


Delegate Sector Composition



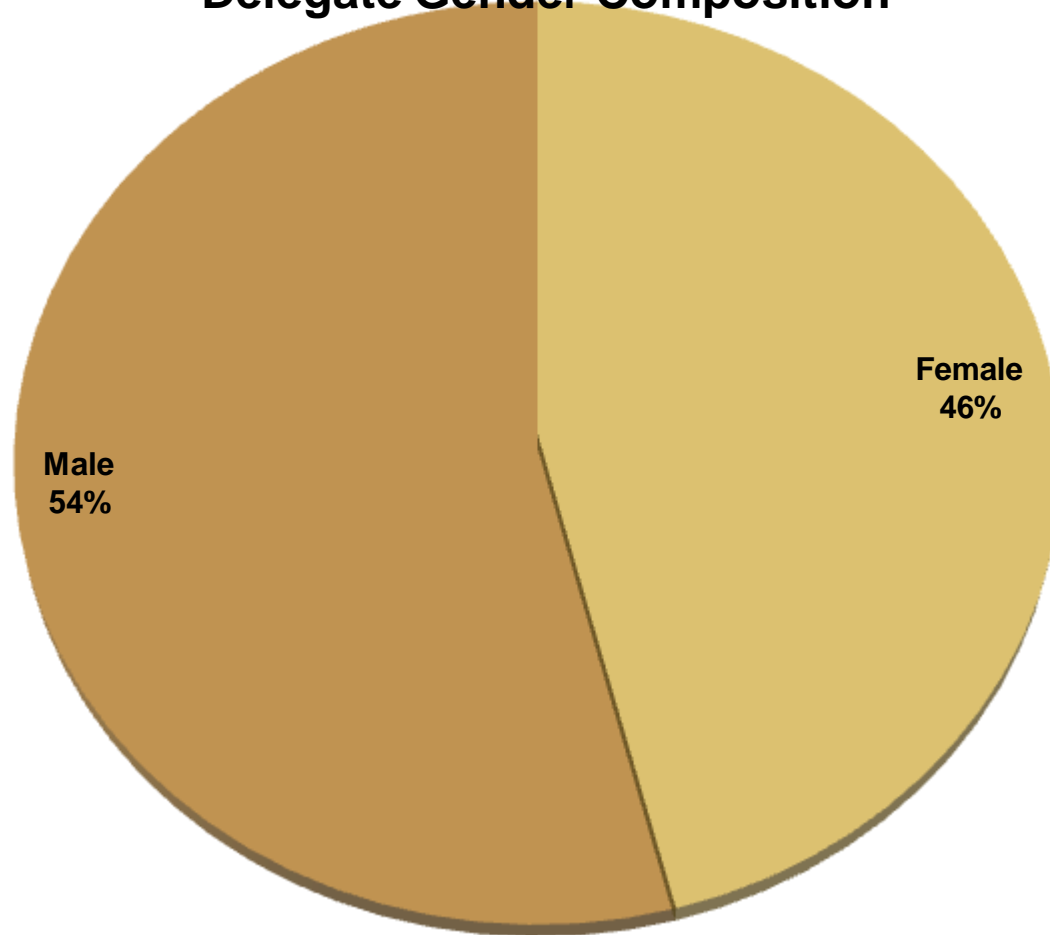


Delegate Role Composition



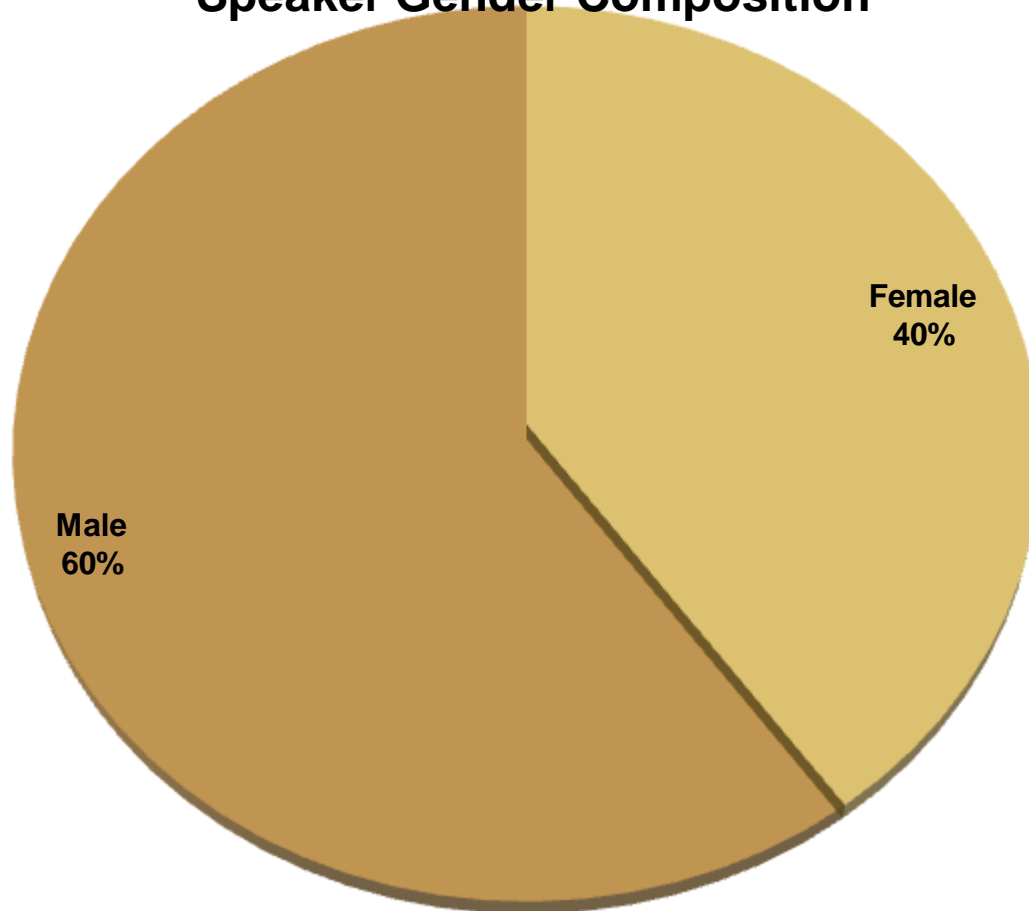


Delegate Gender Composition

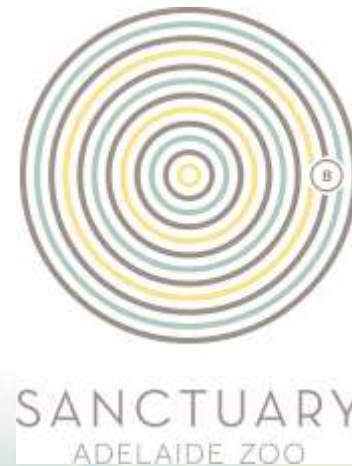
